The *Painted Faces* Series portray the changing perceptions of spirits and their significance in human culture. Nightfall Faces shadow the unnamed dark and light spirits of forest and bush. *Primary Faces* (pictured) represent the named, primal, ancestral spirits of the village. The rattle becomes the rattles of the masked and painted spirit dancers in the clan houses. Harlequin Faces celebrate the festive, carnival faces of town. *Primary Faces*, a painter's book, 3" x 3", 5 pages with concealed rattle plus packet wrap, acrylic on multilayered and cut papers, unique, \$340.

Crafts people create a miniature scene in a pot using stunted trees and plants, and rocks. Potted Gardens is made from authentic Chinese paper cuts, a popular and common folk art. Using scissors or an engraving knife on very thin rice paper, skilled crafts people cut the themes of daily life. It is easy to learn paper cutting, but very difficult to master it. Potted Gardens is 4.25" x 4.5" and comes with matching clamshell case. Edition of 10. \$195.
