

# **Chinese Paper Cuts Series**

These artist books are crafted with authentic paper cuts imported from China. Paper cuts are a very distinctive Chinese art form originating from the 6th century when women used to paste gold and silver foil cuttings onto their hair at the temples, and men used them in sacred rituals. Later, they were used during festivals to decorate gates and windows. After hundreds of years of development, paper cuts have become a very popular decorative folk art. The main cutting tools are scissors or an engraving knife on very thin rice paper. Many crafts people are remarkably good at cutting the themes of daily life. It is easy to learn, but very difficult to master the art of paper cutting.

# Singing to the Birds

Bird Songs is a wood dowel piano hinged book of rare duo-color paper cuts from China. Four intricate paper cut illustrations of women playing different musical instruments to a variety of

beautiful birds. Comes with a dramatic clamshell case. Book size is 11.5" x 6". Unique, \$595.

#### **Curious Cats**

Five Cats and 5 cat poems from writers you will recognize fold into this charming little book. The cats are Chinese papers cuts mounted on stiff pages that unfold like a nautilus. One section holds a parchment paper 10 page signature with the poems that also unfolds like a



nautilus. Closed size is 3.5" x 5", opens to 19" long, comes with matching clamshell case. Edition of 2, \$295.

#### **Potted Gardens**

Chinese potted gardens, similar to the Japanese Bonsai, have been famous for many centuries and are often described as "soundless poetry" or "living sculpture". In a pot no larger than

a wash basin, craftsmen create a miniature natural scene using



stunted trees and plants, and rocks. **Potted Gardens** is an unfolding book of authentic paper cuts. Book size is 4.5" x 4.25", comes with a clamshell case. Edition of 10, \$195.



## Tiger Year

This book sparkles with gilded pages showcasing 6 authentic paper cuts for the year of the tiger, the text tells about the sign of the tiger, lovers and spouses, parents and babies, friends and enemies, health and home, and career and finance for those born in year of the tiger. **Tiger Year** is 18 rigid pages, piano hinged with wood dowels with gilded Tyvek hinges, pages are 6.75" x 6.75", comes with stunning gilded case, unique, \$495.

#### **Commune Women / Commune Workers**

Two very similar books about Chinese land reform under Mao. What was it like? With text and Illustrative paper cuts made from thin rice paper, imported from China, mounted on stiff pages with an interleaving parchment. Both come with a dramatic clamshell case.
